#### 2. ACCESS

##### [Getting to the center of Paris:](#)

- **From Paris-CDG Airport**

- We advise to take a taxi which, depending on traffic, takes between 45 and 60 minutes to travel from Paris-CDG Airport to central Paris.
  - From the airport, there are fixed rates: €56 to Paris Rive Droite and €65 to Paris Rive Gauche.
  - Official taxis can only be found at the stations located at the terminal exits and are recognisable by their illuminated 'TAXI' sign.
  - It is possible to book a taxi in advance to avoid waiting and to obtain a vehicle suited to your needs.
- Make sure to avoid unofficial taxis and favour official companies such as Taxis G7 or Alpha Taxis. Freeriding apps like Uber are also available.
- Public transportation is also available. The **RER B** is the simplest and most direct way to travel between Paris (particularly Gare du Nord and Châtelet) and Paris-CDG. The service runs from 4:50 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. (last arrival at CDG).
- All terminals are connected via the **free CDGVAL shuttle**, which runs inside the airport.

- **From Orly Airport**

- **By taxi**, depending on traffic, takes between 25 and 45 minutes to travel from Paris-Orly Airport to central Paris.
  - From the airport, there are fixed rates: €45 to Paris Rive Droite and €36 to Paris Rive Gauche.
  - Official taxis can only be found at the stations located at the terminal exits and are recognisable by their illuminated 'TAXI' sign.
  - It is possible to book a taxi in advance to avoid waiting and to obtain a vehicle suited to your needs.
  - Make sure to avoid unofficial taxis and favour official companies such as Taxis G7 or Alpha Taxis. Freeriding apps like Uber are also available.
- The **Metro Line 14** connects Paris directly to Paris-Orly airport in about 25 minutes, offering the fastest connection.

### Getting to the venue:

- **By bus:**
  - Bus 24, 77 et 87, stop ministère de l'Économie, des Finances et de la Souveraineté industrielle et numérique.
  - Bus 71, 215, stop Gare de Bercy or Bercy – Arena.
- **By subway:**
  - Metro lines 6 and 14, Bercy station.
  - Metro line 1, Gare de Lyon station.
  - RER A and D, Gare de Lyon station.

### Accessing the venue:

You will be given a badge at the entrance to access the building. The meetings as well as the networking lunch will take place in the same building. **You must present a valid form of ID document to enter the venue.**

- If you are arriving on foot, please go to **139 Rue de Bercy**.
- If you are arriving by car, please go to **145 Rue de Bercy**.
